

Known for patient and medic safety, their new Commander XT ambulance has the largest patient compartment capacity of their fleet. The additional space allows for increased patient care with better lighting and interior set up. Patients have commented on the comfort saying, *"the ambulance is roomy"* and *"the ride is great"*.

Forward facing medic-safe seating is a main feature of the design, which substantially improves paramedic safety. The belted adjustable seats slide and turn as required and reduce the risk of paramedic injuries during crashes, sudden stops or hard maneuvers.



Another key feature is the Ferno iN/Traxx System. This fully adjustable, wall-mounted track system secures loose equipment. Supplies are easily reached from a seated position and changed within minutes.

The ambulance also features a vehicle integrated intelligence system, Crestline's O₂ To Go System and a Stryker Power-PRO XT cot that allows paramedics to easy lift, load and unload patients to and from the ambulance.
